Please have a cuppa and a chat after the morning service.

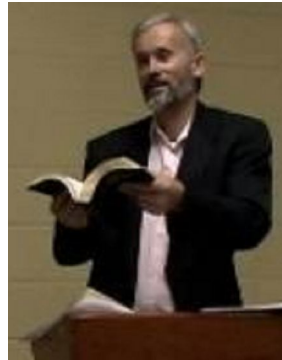
From the pastor's desk
